Course Title: Paramedic in Industry

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Course Description: This course is designed to acknowledge the previous training, knowledge, and skills of licensed Paramedics. It is intended to be an orientation into the expectations, roles, and responsibilities when practicing as an Occupational First Aid (OFA) Attendant. The course is a combination of 16 hours independent study, and 4 hours classroom, and directs the student to areas where OFA practice expectations may differ from the expectations for practice at their current Paramedic level. Successful students will receive a WorkSafeBC Occupational First Aid Level III – Paramedic in Industry certificate which is valid for three (3) years with the stipulation that a valid British Columbia EMA license is maintained throughout the 3-years.

Course Goal(s): To teach the additional skills and knowledge to the Paramedic so that they can function effectively as an Occupational First Aid Attendant in industry.
