COURSE REQUIREMENTS

Transportation Requirements

- 6 vehicles with emergency equipment. 4 sedans and 2 SUVs.
- Arrangements made for delivery and return of vehicles.
- List of vehicles to include unit numbers, cell phone numbers and what location they are from.
- Provision for transportation of instructors to classroom site.

Staff Requirements

- Ensure that all students have completed Incident Command Training Level 100 and Advanced Escorts CRTS902.
- Ensure that all students have received joining instructions (including map and directions)
- Advise students to bring adequate and appropriate dress for the weather.
- List of participating deputies who have current and recognized first aid certificate.

Hotel Requirements

- Does the hotel have firearms storage? If not, arrange local storage with Sheriff's office.
- Safe parking for vehicles? If not, arrange parking at local Sheriff's office, and transportation to and from the hotel.

Facility Requirements

- Classroom to accommodate 12 students plus instructors.



- Screen for use with power Point projector or large whiteboard.
- First Aid/Rescue equipment available and list of local emergency medical/fire contacts.
- Boundary Bay PTEC track booked with Instructor.

Local Authority Notification and Contacts

- Local police notified of the simulation training that will be taking place in their community. Get name and number of contact and provide them with a contact number for us.
- Local Sheriff's offices notified of the simulation training that will be taking place.

Equipment Requirements (Instructors)

- Minimum 18 traffic vests (at LMDC)
- 10 FRS radios (at LMDC)
- Portable whiteboard (at LMDC)
- Outdoor rain tent (at HSHP)
- Course participant manuals (from JI)
- Course presentation materials
- Laptop and multimedia projector
- Signage for public notification of simulation training
