Candidates will have an opportunity to research and discuss “best practice” with regards to skills and knowledge instruction. Candidates will also review and practice the marking and grading criteria to ensure fair and objective evaluations for their students. Successful candidates will extend their Instructor/Evaluator credential for another three years.

Course Goal(s): To provide an opportunity for First Responder Instructor/Evaluators to discuss and share concepts and ideas around instructional “best practice” and to ensure that fair and objective evaluations continue to occur within the First Responder program.
