**Course:** First Responder Provider – Level II (FR II)

Students must:

- have a valid (within the last 12 months) Basic Life Support for Healthcare Provider (CPR “C”) course or equivalent.

*Note:* The First Responder Provider – Level I (FR I) course is not a prerequisite because all FR I course material is covered in FR II.

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**Course Description:**

If you're first on the scene, would you know what to do? Would you be thorough? Confident?

Attain a comprehensive skill base enabling you to effectively perform duties as a First Responder. You'll get an overview of required knowledge, study all content from the First Responder Level I course, and delve into more detailed training to better equip you for emergency response. In this class, learn how to perform organized and prioritized patient assessments and how to manage life-threatening injuries and conditions. In addition, you will enhance your airway management skills and your treatment of other traumatic injuries.

With sixteen-hours of hands-on practical sessions, and lectures from experienced First Responder Instructors, this course is intended to be a thorough study of relevant material to properly equip you for this critical role.

The class size is held to a maximum of 9 participants per instructor and courses are held in communities throughout British Columbia.

Successful participants are eligible to apply for FR II registration/licensure in British Columbia through the Emergency Medical Assistant Licensing Branch.

**Course Goal(s):**

The goal of the course is to equip students with the skills to initiate early assessment and treatment of several life-threatening traumatic injuries as part of an integrated continuum of patient care with other pre-hospital agencies.

**Comments on Delivery Methods:**

Students will benefit greatly from the small and intimate class size as well as the face-to-face classroom setting. Within the classroom and during lab time, the course will focus primarily on three practical areas: developing psychomotor skills; practicing and mastering skills; and following medical patient assessment models. The methodology will include demonstrations, coaching and the provision of feedback by the instructor, as well as ample hands-on student practice.

In order to maximize the relation of student/instructor time, and incorporate as much personalized instruction as possible, class sizes are restricted to 9 students.

Outside of class instruction, students will be expected to allot approximately 2 hours total to pre-course reading.

Note: An additional two hours of classroom time is spent on certification examinations. Therefore the total length of the FR II course is 16 hours.

The First Responder Provider – Level II course is the second of three levels within the First Responder Program at the Justice Institute of British Columbia. There are also endorsement courses available upon completion of Level II and Level III.
